Coconut Custard £3.95



This is one of the traditional and delicious coco-nutty Thai desserts.

The name *Kanom Tauy* literally means 'dessert in a bowl'

The dessert has 2 layers: the sweet pandan custard primary base layer on the bottom with the thick, slightly salty coconut custard on the top. Both layers are eaten together to give an amazing twist to your palate

Sticky Rice with Mango £5.95



Fresh yellow mango on a bed of sweet sticky rice, covered in coconut cream. *Khao-Neow-Mamuang* is among the most popular Thai desserts to eat in and outside of Thailand. In Bangkok, you'll find mango sticky rice everywhere you go during mango season

Banana Fritters £4.95



Fresh banana in a crispy golden batter served with homemade coconut icecream, drizzled with maple syrup and roasted desiccated coconut

Mango Sorbet £3.95



Home-made refreshing mango sorbet served with mango pieces and drizzled with mango coulis then finished with mint leaf

Coconut Ice Cream £3.95



Home-made Coconut milk blended with fresh coconut then sprinkled with peanut and sliced jackfruit
